Mu favourite Asia celebration

is a festival called 'Hanimi' that occurs during the month of April in Japan when everyone has picnics under trees to celebrate the Cherry Blossoms. Different areas of Japan, depending on their climate, celebrate the festival at different times depending on when the flowers are at full bloom. There's something so magical about these celebrations, (It's like standing under a blanket made out of pink cotton candy clouds) It literally makes one stop and smell the flowers!

Mu favourite Asian flowers

are peonies, especially when they're in a shape of a sphere just before they open up. Their round shapes are so clean, yet it's still full of luscious layers and textures. My private Asia beach is the Maldives' Soneva Gili. You are ferried around in speedboats to deserted areas on the beaches where you can have your own private picnic.

My Asia romantic table for two is Gaddis at Hong Kong's Peninsula Hotel.


Mu secret Asia hideawau
